The meeting was called to order at 7:41 p.m.

Minutes:

Minutes of the November 27, 2006 meeting were approved with one correction. Under "Regional Commissioner Reports," paragraph 2, the region should read, "31."

Treasurer's Report:

Lisa May presented the 2007 Budget, with projected income of \$13,500.00, projected expenses of \$11,750.00 and net revenue of \$1,750.00. The projected team fees for 2007 will be a \$100.00 flat fee for all divisions. The per player cost is \$0.76. There was discussion regarding possible inequities in the budget regarding smaller regions versus the larger regions. Lisa said she is open to suggestions on the budget, since this is the first forward looking budget for the Area. Darryl moved to approve the budget and the motion passed.

Lisa presented the Treasurer's Report for January 2007. She reported an ending balance of \$218.37 for the Area. There are still open receivables of \$975.00 for the Fall 2006 U16/19 from Chino. Darryl moved to accept the Treasurer's report and the motion passed.

Referee Administrator Report

Bill Richards reported that in 2006, five people called for advanced or National assessments. One passed for National referee and one passed for National Assessor. In January, two advanced assessments were done. Lisa asked if Bill could help her with a referee who had his advanced badge stolen and who is only listed as intermediate in the eAYSO system. Bill said to e-mail him the information.

Area Tournament:

Please see handout for Area 1B Fall League Champions Tournament results. Ken reported that the U14 boys had to resort to a three team shot to break a tie. The Section Fall League Tournament will be held at the AB Brown Complex in Riverside. Those who advance will go to the Tri-Section Playoffs in Upland. Ken wanted to thank all those who helped with the tournament. However, there were quite a few referees from Chino who did not show up for their assignments.

Area 1B will have referee assignments at the Section tournament. Staff is also needed to help line the fields, check in teams and various other duties.

Spring League:

There is a coaches meeting for the Spring League on Monday, February 5, 2007, 7:30 pm at the AQMD. It will be preceded at 6:30 pm by a referee meeting. The schedule for spring play may be available at that time.

Darryl May will be working on the Spring League schedule. He had questions regarding how La Puerta is configured. Tom B. said that it is available on Saturday and Sunday with two full size fields. There will be three sites per weekend for games. A region won't have back to back weekends for hosting games. The host region will referee the first game. The following games will be refereed by the home team of the previous game. Darryl said he will try to keep the U16/19 games on week nights. He will schedule U10 games with 65 minutes between games, U12 with 75 minutes and U14 with 85 minutes. He wanted to remind each region that referees should dress appropriately and wear an AYSO approved badge.

Mike Machado is the new RC for Chino Hills region. He reported that there were changes to the number of Spring League teams – there are 3 U10B teams, and 1 U12G teams. February 17 is the grand opening of the new Community Park in Chino Hills. They want to run soccer clinics that day. Darryl said that there are no Chino Hills games scheduled for that day.

Ken reminded everyone to always check the web site for any changes to the schedule on the Thursday before games.

Walnut will not be participating with Area B at the lower divisions for Spring League play. Area U will only be participating at the U16/19 level.

Tri-Section Tournament

Ken asked that everyone please plan to attend the Tri-Section Conference, May 11-13, 2007 in Long Beach. They also need staff to help at the conference. Darryl said that he proposed having a kid's place to play and do crafts, to Jeff at Section. The NAGM conference will be in New Orleans on Memorial Day weekend.

Regional Commissioner Reports:

Region 31 – Darryl reported that Diamond Bar will be holding a regional referee class on February 2 & 3, at the AQMD. The cost is \$30.00 at the door. They are also having the adult league sign ups. The second season starts on February 25, 2007. They have 175-200 players, 50 less than the Fall season.

Region 67 – Tom had nothing to report.

Region 779 – Greg reported that this was his final meeting, Mike Machado will be taking over as RC for Chino Hills. He has been appointed to the Parks and Rec Commission. Mike reported that they have a lot of new board members. They will be having a Spring Soccer Fest of five sessions, from February 3 to March 17. He reported that the new Community Park will have the same number of soccer fields – five. However, they will all be artificial turf.

Region 3 – Tom said that the region will be having an intermediate coaching clinic at the Hughes center the first weekend in February.

Region 583 – Chris had nothing to report.

Meeting adjourned at 9:10 pm.
