



AREA 1B Fall 2009 U16-U19 Playoffs

Games scheduled at Chino, Diamond Bar,
South Ontario and Chino Hills

Welcome to the Area 1B Fall 2009 U16-U19 Playoffs.

These guidelines will apply to all competition in this tournament. All coaches MUST have in their possession at all times the properly completed and signed ("wet ink" signature) medical release forms for each player along with their Player ID cards. All players must play at least half of each game per National Rules and Regulations.

The divisions participating in this competition will advance as follows:

U16 and U19 All Divisions:

Only the top four teams from the fall league will move on to the playoffs.

Semi-final games will be played on November 16, 2009.

Finals will be played on November 17, 2009.

Determination of winners:

- WINING team from the semi-finals will move on to the Finals
- TIE – NO Ties. Every game MUST have a winner.
- Forfeited games will be given a score of 1-0 for the winning team.
- -1 point for each red card sending off... for each player, substitute or coach.

Tie Breakers:

- In the event of a tie at the end of full time for a game, a winner will be determined by standard shots from the mark. No overtime periods will be played.

Games:

ALL games must be played. A 15 minute grace period will be allowed from the scheduled start time of the game. If game starts late because a team did not arrive in time, equal time will be taken off each half. Teams should be at the field and ready to play regardless of the weather conditions, unless informed by Area Staff, at least 45 minutes prior to the scheduled start time.

ANY SITUATION NOT COVERED BY THESE GUIDELINES WILL REVERT BACK TO THE AREA 1B GUIDELINES CURRENTLY ACTIVE.
